2.	Chairman's update. <ul style="list-style-type: none">GC spoke briefly regarding recent flooding issues and introduce the purpose of this extraordinary meeting.	
3.	Solar Park. 13/05244/FUL <ul style="list-style-type: none">Revised plans have been submitted. The main concern of the PC is the use of Poulshot Road for construction and of Barley Hill Lane/Corn Close for Maintenance. This because of increased traffic particularly by heavy lorries, near on what is already a dangerous road for pedestrians.It was agreed by the PC that WC should very seriously consider our original submission for a condition that the A361 be used for all access to the proposed site. 4.	Tree work at Higher Green Farm 14/00656/TCA Felling of a Lime Tree <ul style="list-style-type: none">It was agreed that the PC would like to see this significant tree retained. It was agreed that the tree needs maintenance and that Wiltshire Council should insist on a second opinion before any work is done. The letter from the applicant's tree specialist is not clear about the need to fell.	AB
