#### **History of the Village Green**

The Village Green was originally Common Land.

In 1965, the Common Registration Act was passed and in 1968, Poulshot registered its village green. The Green Gardens was first included then excluded.

The Village Green was properly registered under Mr Hues' chairmanship in 2009. It is now protected by certain laws and there is no doubt about its status. Residents with prescribed rights across the green had to register them. A question was asked about what happened to those residents who didn't renew their rights.
